- ❖ Liaise with BOC (Base Operation Centre) via radio or cell phone and determine availability of services and review of the Movement of aircraft and parking locations to ensure ramp safety for daily traffic.

- ❖ Maintain all daily statistical records and ensure end of shift reports are completed.
